6 of 6 Award

Indiana's Economic Growth Region 7 received the 6 of 6 Award once again for the performance of its JAG programs. The following metrices were achieved:

- 91.63% graduate high school
- 75.27% gain employment
- 87.86% work full time
- 88.17% in a full-time positive outcome
- 51.08% enter post-secondary education and/or achieve a career credential
- 97.85% Maintain contact








Carson Hall
